

INGLATERRA EN CASA SUMMER CAMPS INFORMATION



OPTION 1) FOOTBALL CAMPS WITH SUNDERLAND AFC - ASTURIAS & ALICANTE

Camp description

We run a football training programme 100% in English with coaches provided by Sunderland AFC. Students are placed into groups according to their age, and attend a number of classes / sessions per day, from English lessons to coaching sessions.

Staff duties

Staff members are typically responsible for one group of students of a similar age (7–18) and support the students['] learning and welfare during their stay. Everyday tasks involve:

- Helping students with their workbooks and accompanying them in lessons.
- Leading students around the facilities between activities and monitoring them during eating times.
- Assisting Coaches and Teachers during activities and sessions.
- Getting to know their students well and identifying any problems with fitting into the programme or group.
- Running engaging and fun activities for students to do outside of lessons and coaching sessions.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided on site; breakfast, lunch and dinner is provided in the canteen.

Monitor, Teacher or Assistant

Dates

The football camps take place at two different locations in Spain, at different dates. Jobs are available at either individual or both camps. To find out more about a typical day at the football camp, watch this video here

OPTION 2) FARM CAMP - ALICANTE

Camp description

Students aged 7 – 14 live in a 100% English environment produced on a beautiful farm in the Alicante countryside. Students live on site alongside staff and participate in activities relating to their surroundings all day every day. Students go on excursions to the beach and theme parks as well as receive more traditional lessons in the on site classrooms. Animals live on the farm too, and the camp has a very relaxed natural environment.

Staff duties

Teachers must take on both a teaching and counselling role, and be able to look after students day and night as well as run activities and lessons relating to the language aims of the programme.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided on site; breakfast, lunch and dinner is provided in the canteen.

OPTION 3) SUMMER SCHOOL HOST FAMILY PROGRAMME - ALICANTE

Camp Description

Students from all across Spain choose this camp in order to have a similar experience to living in the UK without having to leave Spain. Students come for two weeks and are housed with British Host Families who live in the area, also attending a school every day for lessons and activities. Students receive classes such as Drama, Media, Cooking, Science, Conversation & English, and also go to the beach & pool once a week, with many afternoon activities and gymkhanas. Two programmes are run in this school over the Summer, the Half Day programme (from 09:15 – 13:00 for ages between 3–10) and the Full Day programme (from 09:15 – 17:00 for ages between 7–18).

Staff Duties

This camp is the most school-like programme, and it is run in a similar way to a school. Staff are expected to share break-time and lunch duties as well as create lesson & activity plans relevant for students. Staff attend the school from 08:45 and students leave at 17:00, though there is a daily meeting which can go from 17:00 – 17:30/18:00.

Accommodation

As students don't live on site, teachers will have their evenings free to use as they wish. Flats can be provided in the vicinity of the school at a small cost (150€ or less for the entire programme). To find out more about this programme, watch this video here

Roles available

Teachers of English, Conversation, Drama, Media, Cooking, Music. Monitor and Assistant roles are also available. Some positions are available for the entire 5 week stay, but some positions are only available for a 3 week stay.

OPTION 4) SUMMER CLUB - VALENCIA

Course description

This programme takes place in our Academy in Valencia, and many of our year-round students attend the club over a period of four to five weeks. Students are split into groups according to their ages & levels, and receive classes from the same teacher all day every day (9.00 – 13.00) from Monday to Friday.

Staff duties

Staff are expected to create decent lesson plans according to our methodology of learning through diverse activities and fun. Teachers must create lesson plans according to their lesson timetable, and ensure their classes receive all their lessons of cooking, science, drama etc.

Accommodation

This is only a half day programme and thus accommodation is not provided.

Roles available

Teachers who are able to teach a diverse selection of activities as well as being able to maintain control of their classroom.
